**PETER'S PENCE:** (2nd COLLECTION: 29/30 June 2024) by reason of the bond of unity and charity, the bishops of the Church, with their people, join together to produce those means which the Holy Father and the Apostolic See need to exercise works of mercy and charity and its service of the Universal Church. **ST VINCENT'S PARISH COMMUNITY FEAST DAY:** This year we will be holding a special celebration Mass to mark the Feast of our church Patron Saint, St Vincent de Paul. Everyone is invited and we hope all parts of our community will come together and participate in this special Parish celebration.
