**NATIONAL LOCKDOWN:** The Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales issued the following statement from the President and the Vice President of the Conference on National Lockdown. This statement was issued on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Here is the opening paragraph: "Today Parliament passed into law the Regulations governing many aspects of the activity in the whole of England until the 2<sup>nd</sup> December. These regulations prohibit the gathering of people for <u>COMMUNAL</u> worship in Churches and other religious buildings.

Churches remain open and in use for activities other than Communal worship, including prayer and support for those in need. Funeral Masses and funeral services may be held. (Please refer to the <u>Regulations</u> for places of Worship see paragraph 18) and associated <u>Guidance</u>. Our Archbishop John Wilson sent us a letter of support and encouragement. With regards clergy support to the local community. We can continue to support the streaming of the Mass, and the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. As a parish we are in a position to offer both. All Masses and the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be streamed. **CHRISTMAS PREPARATIONS**: Not withstanding uncertainties for Christmas preparations I am making the following provisions for the traditional Christmas Services for the parish. For this Christmas I am making the following suggestions:

On Christmas Eve: Thursday 24th December two masses will be said at **4.00pm and 5.30pm** with children in mind. The number of people present must not exceed the figure of 60. These Masses will be followed by MIDNIGHT MASS.
