The Pope's Global Prayer Network

Over many years, the Popes have identified particular concerns, challenges facing the world and the Church's mission, for which they invite our prayers. These monthly Intentions are entrusted to the People of God via the Apostleship of Prayer, now better known as the Pope's Global Prayer Network. It's not a Jesuit work as such but a church ministry. Since 2015 the UK National Director is Fr. David Stewart SJ, who lives in the Diocese, at St. Thomas Garnet House, Clapham. He is sometimes available to come to parishes to present on the Network (and even give a hard-pressed PP a weekend off!), also to discuss other ways of involving parishes and chaplaincies, such as Days and Weeks of Guided Ignatian Prayer. Not a movement in any sense, we are responsible also for promoting the new Pope Video online channel and the Click-to-Pray website and App., encouraging people to join in this spiritual pathway, a Way of the Heart.
